Over the past year, the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts (AOPC) has undertaken to require all judicial districts to fully implement the federal and state requirements for full access to all courts for LEP individuals including *pro se* litigants. This CLE seminar seeks to empower attorneys, paralegals, court administrators, judges, and court interpreters to each understand their roles in making those requirements a functioning reality.

The importance of full implementation of these requirements is demonstrated by a recently released study by the Sheller Center for Social Justice at Temple Law School, "Barriers to Justice - Limited English Proficient Individuals and Pennsylvania's Minor Courts" (Feb. 2015). The report concluded that many of Pennsylvania's Magisterial District Justice Courts often failed to ensure that people with limited English proficiency understood court procedures and hearings.

We have worked closely with the Community Justice Project and Community Legal Services over the past year to make Pennsylvania courts, courthouses, and Pennsylvania administrative agencies more responsive to the needs of limited English proficient litigants. We would like to encourage you to have staff participate in this CLE so that they can be more effective advocates on behalf of these communities.

PBI's Tuition Waiver Program for Legal Services and Public Interest Attorneys
